CAMPUS SITES

JAMES A. DILTSINSON LIBRARY

The library has a book collection of more than 500,000 volumes which is reinforced by 5,000 periodical subscriptions, 70,000 microfiche, more than 300,000 government documents, and 50,000 non-book materials (including records, tapes, cassettes and films). The library also has a special collections department which holds collections of Nevadaiana (including photographs, oral history, tapes, maps and manuscripts); the university archives; and a renowned collection of gaming.



JAMES R. DICKINSON LIBRARY

The library has a book collection of more than 508,000 volumes which is reinforced by 6,000 periodical subscriptions; 718,000 microfilms; more than 226,000 government documents; and 58,000 non-book materials (including records, tapes, cassettes and films). The library also has a special collections department which holds collections of Nevadiana (including photographs, oral history, tapes, maps and manuscripts); the university archives; and a renowned collection on gaming.



THE FLASHLIGHT

The flashlight is a very intriguing piece of artwork. It is 38 feet tall and weighs 74,000 pounds. This steel sculpture was designed by the internationally acclaimed artist, Claes Oldenberg. The sculpture is located at the northern end of campus between the Artemus W. Ham Concert Hall and Judy Bayley Theatre.



MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY

Being situated in the Southwestern United States, this museum brings something to the residents of Las Vegas who do not get the chance to see the wildlife located in the diverse Mojave desert. Not only can you see a part of history, but you also get to see many different animals--some alive and some preserved.



STUDENT UNION

The Donald C. Moyer Student Union has almost everything a student could ask for. There are six restaurants with plenty of dining tables. If you are in the mood to relax there is a television room and a wide screen TV/video room. If you need to study, you can go to the bookstore to buy your supplies and then sit down in the study room. There is also a game room with pool tables for those pool sharks. In addition, there is a ballroom, meeting rooms, student government offices, student newspaper office, KUNV radio station and an information booth.



THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The Thomas & Mack Center is the home of the six time Big West champion UNLV Running Rebel Basketball Team. The seating capacity is 18,500, which has been exceeded on many occasions. The Thomas & Mack Center is also used for various concerts, shows and sporting events (including the World Basketball League champion Las Vegas Silver Streaks).

I would like to enlighten you on some background history of the University itself:

<u>Year</u>	<u>Event</u>
1951	University of Nevada, Reno offered the first extension courses at Las Vegas High School with a student body total of 12.
1957	Formally established by legislature, the University was founded officially as a southern regional division of the state university. Maude Frazier Hall was the first classroom and administration building established.
1964	First commencement ceremony took place, granting degrees to twenty-nine students.
1965	The campus was given the name of Nevada Southern University.
1968	Full autonomy and equality with the Reno campus was established.
1969	The Board of Regents renamed the campus University of Nevada, Las Vegas.
1987	The university celebrated its 30th year of service.

UNLV is a co-ed, 335 acre campus governed by a nine member elected Board of Regents. They offer 64 undergraduate degree programs, 45 master degree programs, and 8 doctorate degree programs. The school offers a solid foundation in humanities, fine arts, mathematics, science, english and social sciences. The school's mascot is the Rebels and their colors are scarlet and silver. Furthermore, UNLV has many opportunities for everyone while working toward their

goals which include: striving for excellence in teaching, generating new knowledge through research, and supporting public service programs for the community. Our colony supports these goals and will work toward seeing these goals become a reality.

ENROLLMENT STATISTICS:

The enrollment for the Fall of 1987 was 13,778 students. There were 6,982 students attending UNLV full-time with the other 6,796 attending part-time. Residents accounted for 87.5% of the student body while 12.5% were non-residents. UNLV has a very good full-time student to full-time faculty ratio of 21:1.

**HISTORY OF
BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION
AND
ENROLLMENT STATISTICS**



Frank and Estella Beam Hall is UNLV's five story business building which was named after the parents of the major donor, Thomas T. Beam. It is one of the largest buildings at UNLV and is the home of the colleges of: 1) Hotel Administration and, 2) Business and Economics.

This 115,000 sq. ft. building was completed in 1983. It has seminar rooms modeled after executive board rooms, a reading room, research facilities, microcomputers, CDC Cyber 172 and Harris H800 computers.

The Business and Economics undergraduate programs are as follows: Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, Finance, Management, Marketing and Public Administration. Their graduate programs include: Accountancy, Economics, MBA Programs and MPA programs. Furthermore, for the convenience of those students who work full time, there are 143 evening courses offered.

ENROLLMENT STATISTICS:

There are 2,933 business majors and 70 full time faculty members. Also there are approximately 225 students enrolled in the MBA programs with 20% being full-time students and the other 80% work full-time.

**HISTORY OF
HOTEL ADMINISTRATION
AND
ENROLLMENT STATISTICS**

The college of Hotel Administration has a very strong and challenging program to offer to the students. Aside of the core requirements the students are required to find 800 clock hours of paid employment before their final semester. The college gets much support from local business to help the students out. Furthermore, the college has an average of 85 companies conducting 2000 interviews per year.

The college is located in Frank and Estella Beam Hall and offers a full size kitchen, 250 seat dining room and bar, and a demonstration kitchen. The college also has their own private computer, casino and accounting labs.

ENROLLMENT STATISTICS:

There are 900 students enrolled from 40 states and 26 countries. Twenty-seven full-time professors teach along with many part-time professors--all with backgrounds in the industry and therefore teach from experience.

Back Theta Delta colony was its first year on December 14, 1957 when regional Director Paul Garcia and District Director William Joseph Stone met Dr. Mayo at the College of Business Administration at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. The three discussed the opportunity a chapter of Delta Sigma Pi could provide to this rapidly growing campus. Dr. Mayo and the university itself, eager to expand the business college's public image, gave Paul and William the preliminary go ahead to take action.

Paul Garcia's second visit to our university was due to an invitation from our students to participate in what was to become known as the "Business Week" event on March 15, 1958. This was instrumental for Paul in gathering the support needed from students. As well as other Business and Hotel majors, Paul met Brian Nelson, Fred Rucio, Ibrahim Sabagh, Steve Decker, and a brother from Delta Pi chapter, Chris Prohaska, who were all later crucial to the colony's birth.

By mail Paul invited the group of five interested students for the first meeting at UNLV on June 25, 1958. More organizational meetings held July 15th and August 5th and 12th led to a foundation being laid as well as temporary officers established by name. As our numbers grew and interest spread to other areas of Nevada territory the maintenance of the colony was quickly made a priority. As a reinforcement to Delta Sigma Pi's commitment to support, we

More organizational meetings held July 16th and August 6th and 13th led to a foundation being laid as well as temporary officers established by draw. As our enthusiasm progressed and interest spread to others, the actual understanding of the mountainous tasks ahead of us quickly surfaced. As a reinforcement to Delta Sigma Pi's commitment to support, we

all met with Director of Chapter Services, Dean Ferguson on his first visit to Las Vegas.

As directed by Paul Garcia, objectives by order of importance and chronology were met. Once the name of Beta Theta Delta, (Business in the Desert), was born by brainstorm, more permanent officers were elected and appointed to share in responsibilities. We quickly laid out a strategy for recruiting, petitioned for colonization to Michael Mazur, and obtained university recognition by the second week of fall semester.

Meetings were established as biweekly on Saturdays, a calendar of events was prepared, and we became recognized as a campus organization by the student government, CSUN.

As excitement spread, a successful recruiting campaign launched a core of about 20 students into the fall's activities. The most memorable events being our barbeque at Foxridge Park, our first professional speaker Kathy Roybar, football games, regionals, a grafitti party, and the first UNLV mock elections. By mid-semester, a few officers had changed positions and new committees were formed. Word of mouth recruiting had become our biggest asset. As finals approached for the fall of 1988, a final push for members,

(spawned by regional's ideas), served to carry us through the holidays.

Beta Theta Delta, now older and wiser, but still groggy from the holidays, met twice in executive board meetings to rekindle the colony spirit. Having hammered out bylaws under the guidance of Lisa Brewer, we then progressed to our agenda of preparing for a spring initiation.

We all knew full well that unless we moved quickly on meeting our deadlines, a spring pinning and initiation might not be feasible. Brother Chris Prohaska traveled to Riverside, California to witness our closest neighboring colony's initiation and banquet. At this time Chris Rondini, an alumni from Delta Sigma chapter, Loyola Marymount University was appointed district director by Paul Garcia.

As Beta Theta Delta worked through it's most immediate policy decisions, fees were set, the college of hotel was approved to be included, and elections were set to be held each semester. We then elected and appointed new officers for Spring of 1989 as shown within the petition.

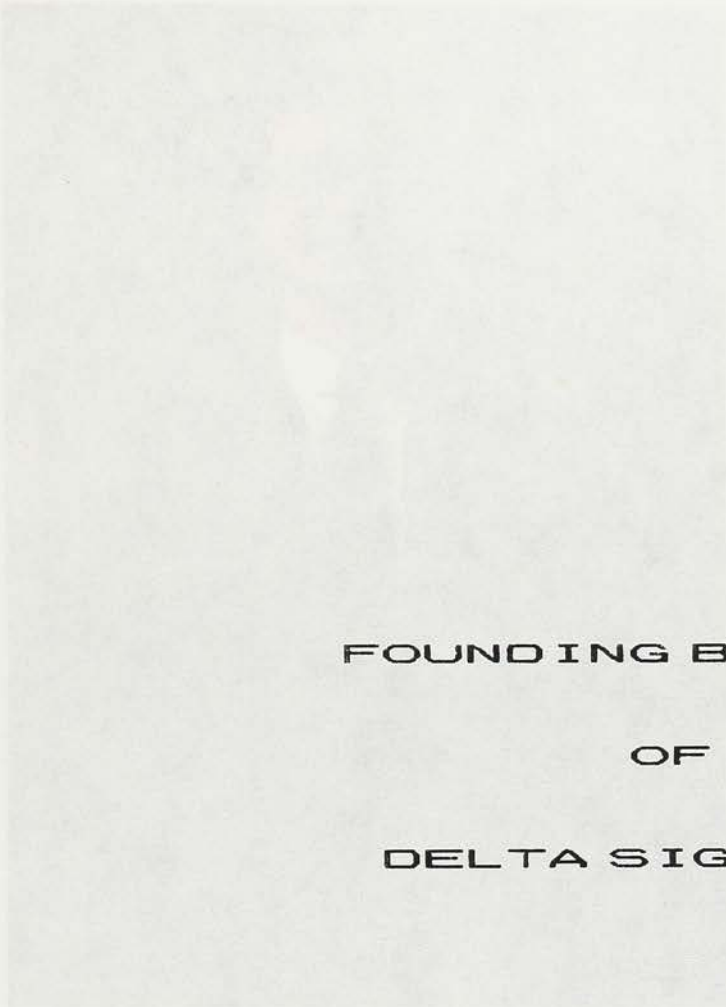
